RULES FOR THE LITTLE MISS AND LITTLE MISTER MACOUPIN COUNTY FAIR CONTEST

1. Contestant must be a U.S. Citizen and a permanent resident of Macoupin County.
2. He/She must be four or five years old by the day of the contest.
3. He/She cannot have been a previous Little Miss or Mister Macoupin County Fair Contestant.
4. He/She must not be a professional model (having accepted payment for modeling and/or be listed with a modeling agency.)
5. Contestants will appear twice, once on stage and be interviewed by a queen contestant for judging, and once in a group performance.
6. No change of clothing is needed. Contestants are to wear dressy clothes; however, boys do not need to wear suits and girls are not to wear long dresses.
7. Judging will be based on: CUTENESS – STAGE PRESENCE – CHARM & PERSONALITY – POSTURE
8. The decision of the judges is final.
9. The boy/girl chosen Little Mister/Miss Macoupin County Fair may or may not be asked throughout the year to escort the Miss Macoupin County Fair Queen. The children will participate at the fair, local parades, etc. A schedule of appearances will be provided at a later date.
10. Magnetic signs will NOT be provided by the Macoupin County Fair Association; however, parents, if they wish, may purchase a sign for their children. Convertibles for children must be obtained by their parents unless further stated.
11. Prizes:
Each contestant receives a dollar.
First Prize Winner receives \$25.00, a trophy and crown.
Second Prize Winner receives \$20.00 and a trophy.
Third Prize Winner receives \$15.00 and a trophy.
