- Weigh in: 9 am to 11 am Tuesday of the fair. Weigh in will start with Macoupin County Auction Animals first, followed by breed in alphabetical order with crossbreds at the end
- All Purebred Barrows will be weighed unless there are fewer than 5 entries per breed, Classes will be separated via weight into equal/fair classes, If multiple weights are same and class size is larger than premium, classes will split by last name of exhibitor
- Crossbreed barrows and gilts weigh-in and are divided into 5 classes the day prior to the show.
- State number of pens with entry. Pens will be assigned by swine superintendents. Minimum 2 pigs per pen. Please bring your own dividers if needed.
- No straw allowed. Sawdust bedding available at no charge.
- We reserve the right to combine classes if there is only one exhibitor in a class.
- All hogs must be on the grounds by 8:00 a.m. Tuesday, June 5 and in pens by 9:00 a.m.
- All wire, cans, bottles, and garbage shall be placed in containers.
- All show boxes, feed, and cots must be kept in the area of individual stalls on the far north and far south alleyways along the outer perimeter of the show barn and not in the metal gated stalls
- All effective dates are the current year.
- Junior Swine Show open to any Junior.
- At the conclusion of the open/junior swine show there will be 2 showmanship classes (Junior 8-13 and Senior 14-19).
- There will be a showmanship sign up sheet available Tuesday evening. Name and age must be included
- Showmanship prizes are donated by the Mike Hemann family and the Bob Thompson Memorial fund.
