### **Specific Department Rules:**

- Exhibitors may purchase a pass if they feel it is necessary. You must be an exhibitor at the fair to purchase a pass. Exhibitors passes will get only the exhibitor into the front gate.
- All Blue Ribbon Winners will be considered for Sweepstakes offered, without making entry.
- All flowers must be grown by exhibitors and must furnish containers; no florist's flowers should be used.
- When the exhibitor does not follow the rules, the exhibit will be disqualified.
- Exhibits should be in prime show conditions.
- CUT FLOWERS WILL BE JUDGED ACCORDING TO SUITABILITY, coloring, relation of container to flower or flowers, and artistic appearance, SHOULD INCLUDE ATTACHED FOLIAGE WHEN POSSIBLE.
- All cut flowers ONLY from the Wednesday show may be removed on Thursday from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. or before 9:30 a.m. on Friday. ALL potted plants and arrangements are to be left for display until removal on Sunday.
- Wedging (the use of an oasis, cotton, wood, foam, paper towel, etc.) is allowed in cut flower displays.
- For cut flower displays of hostas, roses and daylilies the name of the variety should be written on the back of the tag if the name is known.

**Spike** – (sp) means many flowers attached by a short stem along one main central stem as gladiolus.

Stalk – (st) is a single stem composed of a few flowers

Double - (dbl)

- All arrangements must be completed prior to entering the building.
- All arrangements should be newly designed each year.
- All exhibits must be brought to the Art Hall by 9:30 a.m. for Wednesday and Friday shows. NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED ON TUESDAY EVENING.
- Exhibitors and their helpers should not touch or move other exhibitors' entries. Ask a superintendent if help is needed to find room for an exhibit. Once all your entries are placed please exit the exhibit area.
- \*\*Special Notice: ALL CUT FLOWERS MUST BE IN CLEAR VASES OR CONTAINERS; ALL OTHERS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED! Judges must be able to count the items.
