- All grains must be in 1-gallon wide mouth glass jars with lids on.
- All popcorn exhibits 10 ears in a wide mouth glass jar.
- All Blue Ribbon winners will be considered for sweepstakes without making entry.
- Supts in each department may use their own discretion in handling entries on entry day and day of removal.
- PREMIUM CHECKS WILL NOT BE ISSUED WITHOUT EXHIBITOR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. NO EXCEPTIONS.
